

Amendment Flashcards

At the beginning of the 2011-2012 school year it will be expected of you to know the 27 amendments to the Constitution. To help familiarize yourself with each amendment, flashcards must be made.

On one side write the number of the amendment.

On the other side, (in laymen's terms) write the basic rights and/or policies laid out in the amendment.

example:

side 1
1 st Amendment
side 2
Freedom of Speech Freedom of Press Freedom of Religion Freedom of Assembly Freedom of Petition
