

Charlotte Edison Collegiate Institute

Eligibility Criteria

The Collegiate Institute will be available to qualified rising high school juniors.

Criteria for enrollment are as follows:

- Earn at least 14 credits by the end of sophomore year
- Receive a passing score on FCAT reading and FCAT math during the sophomore year
- Earn a 3.5 un-weighted cumulative grade point average at the end of the sophomore year
- Meet one of the following testing requirements:
 - 100 on all subsections of the FCLEPT OR
 - 1100 on the SAT, OR
 - 25 composite on the ACT
- Obtain teacher and counselor recommendations
- Successfully complete a writing sample
- PCHS requires students to maintain a 3.0 un-weighted overall Edison College grade point average to continue in the program. Students who fall below the 3.0 required GPA will be placed on academic probation at Edison College for one semester. A review of the student's GPA in the next term will determine program continuation. Students whose GPAs are not satisfactory after probation will not be allowed to continue in CEI.
