

## *School, State and District Assessments*

Certain demands are placed upon students who are considering college. Since admission is selective, students must be certain that they qualify. The more competitive colleges have more extensive requirements.

Colleges prefer that an applicant has a substantial standardized test history. For this reason Port Charlotte High School students take the following tests as mandated by the Department of Education as well as initiated by Port Charlotte High School's Site Based Progress Monitoring Plan, "Framework for Student Success" for the purpose of progress monitoring and data-driven instruction.

FCAT Reading 2.0

Algebra I EOC

PSAT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test) - optional (not a National Merit qualifying year).

### **Grade 10:**

FCAT Reading 2.0--passing score required for graduation

FCAT Writing

Geometry EOC

Biology EOC

PSAT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test) - optional (not a National Merit qualifying year).

ACT Plan

FAIR—Florida Assessments in Reading (levels 1-3)

PC Writes, PC Reads, PC Solves, PC Discovers Progress Monitoring

ACT/SAT/CPT or PERT—Spring Test—*one is required for students planning to enroll in a dual credit course in grade 11*



### **Grade 11:**

FCAT Reading 2.0 (retakes) if needed

US History EOC (initiates school year 2012-2013)

PSAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test - (optional) Recommended

ACT, SAT I, and/or CPT/PERT (optional) Recommended—spring administration—*one is required for students planning to enroll in a dual credit course in grade 12. College-bound students are highly advised to take these tests starting in the spring of their junior year so that college applications can be sent with scores attached in the fall of the senior year.*

SAT II (optional)—recommended upon completion of specified honors and advance placement courses

### **Grade 12:**

FCAT Reading 2.0 (retakes) if needed

ACT, SAT I, and/or CPT/PERT—(optional) Recommended

SAT II (*Some colleges require an achievement test in certain academic areas. Students should check their respective college handbook or web sites and see their counselors for more information*)
